Epistle Readings Hebrews 2:11-18 Hebrews 4:14-5:6 Gospel Readings Luke 1:23-38 Mark 8:34-9:1

CHRIST IS IN OUR MIDST! HE IS AND EVER SHALL BE!

Troparion (Resurrection)

Let the heavens rejoice! Let the earth be glad! For the Lord has shown strength with His arm. He has trampled down death by death. He has become the first born of the dead. He has delivered us from the depths of hell, and has granted to the world great mercy.

Troparion (Veneration of the Cross)

O Lord, save Thy people, and bless Thine inheritance. Grant victories to the Orthodox Christians, over their adversaries; and by virtue of Thy Cross, preserve Thy habitation.

Troparion (Annunciation)

Today is the beginning of our salvation, the revelation of the eternal mystery! The Son of God becomes the Son of the Virgin as Gabriel announces the coming of Grace. Together with him let us cry to the Theotokos: Hail, O Full of Grace, the Lord is with You!

Kontakion (Veneration of the Cross)

Now the flaming sword no longer guards the gates of paradise; it has been mysteriously quenched by the wood of the Cross! The sting of death and the victory of hell have been vanquished for Thou, O my Savior, didst come and cry to those in hell: Enter again into Paradise.

Kontakion (Annunciation)

O Victorious Leader of Triumphant Hosts! We, your servants, delivered from evil, sing our grateful thanks to you, O Theotokos! As you possess invincible might, set us free from every calamity so that we may sing: Hail, O unwedded Bride!

Veneration After dismissal from Liturgy, Fr. John and Dn. Stefan will stand before the central icon and the choir will sing "Before Thy Cross ..." three times while Fr. John and all present come forward one by one for the appropriate veneration and bow-downs.

Hymn for the Veneration of the Cross Before Thy Cross, we bow down in worship, O Master, and Thy holy Resurrection, we glorify.

Hymn to the Theotokos for Annunciation O earth, announce good tidings of great joy: O heavens, praise the glory of God! Since she is a living Ark of God let no profane hand touch the Theotokos. But let the lips of believers unceasingly sing to her, praising her in joy with the angel's song: "Rejoice, O Lady, full of grace, the Lord is with thee!"
